I am delighted to welcome you to our 2014 Convocation Ceremony. In particular, I welcome with joy our Visitor, the President and Commander in



Chief of Nigerian Armed Forces, His Excellency, Dr. Goodluck Ebele Jonathan GCFR. We are also delighted to welcome His Excellency, the Executive Governor of Imo State, Owelle Rochas Anayo Okorocha OON, and other State Governors here present.

In a special way, I welcome our Honourable Minister of Education, Mallam Ibrahim Shekarau CON and the Minister of State for Education, Professor Viola Onwuliri. We congratulate you both on your recent appointments and wish you a very successful tenure of office. In like manner, I welcome other members of the Federal and State Executive Councils here present. Also I acknowledge here the August presence of our Distinguished Senators, Members of the Federal House of Representatives, and Members of State Houses of Assembly.

Vita Abba, has served out their tenure, thus paving the way for the 10th Governing Council, headed by another seasoned and distinguished Nigerian, Chief (Dr.) Emmanuel Enemuo, a reknowned and accomplished Medical Doctor. The University is





sincerely grateful to Engr. Vita Abba and all the Members of the 9th Governing Council for their selfless contributions to the development of the University; and most especially for the transformational achievements recorded by this University in the areas of physical Infrastructure and Academic Development during their tenure.
