Abstract

The study examined the vocational skill acquisition and entrepreneurship development in Imo State, Nigeria. The specific objectives were to examine the socio economic characteristics of the respondents; identify factors that determine vocational skill acquisition in Imo State and make policy recommendation. Data used for this study were collected with the aid of structural questionnaire administered to 100 randomly selected respondents from Slocal government area of Imo state. Data were analysed using descriptive statistics namely; mean percentage frequency distribution as well as multinomial logit regression model. The result showed that majority (62%) of the sampled respondents were female. Majority fell within the age bracket of (25-35) years of age. The result further showed that age, sex, interest, location, and finance were the major determinants of vocational skill acquisition in the study area. Vocational skill acquisition is important for entrepreneur development in the state. It is recommended that government should come up policies that are not gender bias so as to carry along the vulnerable groups in the society for such skill acquisition.
